1st REGIONAL RONDALLA MUSIC CAMP

**TO: Schools Division Superintendents
Heads of Public and Private Schools**

1. As an offshoot of the Regional Rondalla Workshop conducted by DepED Region V last December 3-6, 2017, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will hold the 1st Regional Rondalla Music Camp on December 14-16, 2018 in Legazpi City in a venue to be announced later.
2. The objective of the 3-day activity are:
 - a. provide avenue for organized rondalla to perform before a big audience in a festival;
 - b. preserve and promote for posterity the culture of rondalla playing;
 - c. enhance skills in playing rondalla instruments; and
 - d. strengthen camaraderie among rondalla players, teachers, trainers and coaches.
3. The participants in this activity are pupils, students, teachers, and trainers of existing rondalla in the elementary and high school levels both in the private and public schools. Students and teachers from the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) who are majors in Instruments and members of the Regional Teachers' Rodalla (RETRO) are required to attend.
4. Travelling and other incidental expenses and a registration fee of three hundred pesos only (Php300.00) to defray expenses for the meals of the technical working group, Supplies and Materials, training kits, certificates, awards and honorarium of trainers, venue rental; water, electricity and janitorial services of billeting quarters, handouts and other incidental expenses, shall be charged each participant chargeable against local, MOOE, SEF, Cultural Club funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Participants shall bring their own food provisions for three days, beddings, camp materials, and respective rondalla instruments during the said activity. Selected elementary and secondary schools in Legazpi City Division will serve as the billeting quarters. Expected arrival in the venue is day 0, December 13, 2018.
6. The Chairman of the TWG is expected to submit a Documentation to the Youth Formation Division, DepEd Central Office, through this Office, after the activity has been conducted.
7. Any savings that will be incurred from this activity will be utilized to purchase Instruments for the Regional Teachers Rondalla.
