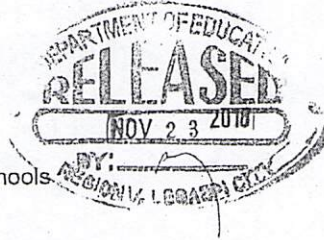

The registration fee will be **P3,995.00 (as approved by the PRC for CPD credits)**, inclusive of food and lodging, seminar kits, and other materials. The participants are expected to be at the venue a day before the seminar. Lodging on December 7 is free but the food for dinner is not included. Travel expenses for board/lodging and other incidental expenses of the seminar shall be charged against the local funds and subject to existing accounting rules and regulation. This seminar/workshop will be considered as business official time.

A bonus (special icebreaker) of self-defense orientation will be given from 7:00-9:00 AM on the second day, teaching participants on how to use their personal belongings like: ballpens, ID's, ATM cards, shoes, keys, books, bags, etc. that will serve as weapons to defend themselves when encountering unnecessary assaults or any physical stressful situations. A martial arts expert from USA will be the guest-instructor on the said "Special Icebreaker" time. Participants are encouraged to bring jogging pants and shirts for this purpose.

Early-bird registrants of P3,995.00 can avail of a ten percent discount (10%) thus paying only P3,595.50. The deadline of the early-bird promo is November 23, 2018.
