

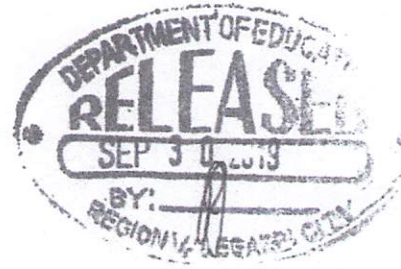

Pursuant to DepEd Memo No. 114, s. 2019, the Philippine High School for the Arts (PSHA) is now accepting applications to the Annual National Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS) for School Year 2019-2020. - identify and develop artistically gifted and talented children to become artists of excellence in the field of folk dance, ballet, music, theater, creative writing, and visual arts.
- ensure a continuing source of artists of excellence and leaders in the preservation, conservation, and promotion of the Filipino artistic and cultural traditions.
