

Mural Painting Guidelines

1. The mural painting is open to the following:
 - a. to all College students enrolled and certified by their respective Deans in public and private HET's of Bicol Region;
 - a. to all employees of DENR V, other National Government Agencies, non-government offices and Local Government Units.
2. Each group must be composed of two (2) to three (3) members.
3. The theme of the mural "**Save Coral Triangle: Stop Plastic Pollution & Waste**".
4. A painting on illustration board (1/4 or 15 inches x 20 inches landscape) using water based paint must be submitted to DENR V - Conservation and Development Division-Coastal Resources and Foreshore Management Section on or before June 03, 2019.
5. Screening and selection of qualified entries will be on June 5, 2019. Qualifiers will be notified by the DENR V thru call or text on June 6, 2019.
6. Entries of those not selected will become property of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources V.

7. Twenty (20) entries will be considered as a qualified entries for the actual mural painting on June 14, 2019 (**Student category— 10 entries, Employee category—10 entries**) at DENR V, Rawis, Legazpi City.

8. Each qualified group will be provided their designation number and wall on competition day through draw lots. They must work within the designated competition area.

9. Qualified participants will be given 1 whole day (June 14, 2019, 8am to 5pm) to finish their art work. However, those who did not finish their art work shall continue their work on the next day to complete it.

10. The qualified participants should bring their own tools (pencils, brushes, paint pallet, etc). The organizer will provide the necessary paints in the actual mural painting donated by Boysen Company.

11. The criteria for judging will be as follows:

Visual Impact.....	35%
Relevance to the theme.....	35%
Originality.....	30%
Total	100%

12. The decision of judges shall be final and irrevocable.

13. There will be three (3) major winners for each category. Cash will be provided for 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners in each category.

Consolation prizes will be given to non-winning groups. Certificates will also be given to winners and participants during the awarding ceremony.

14. Announcement of winners will be on June 14, 2019, 5:30pm at DENR V, Rawis, Legazpi City.

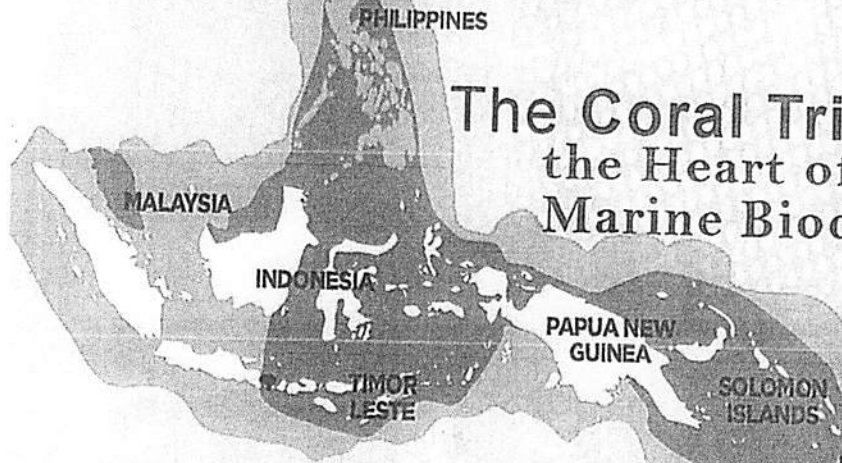

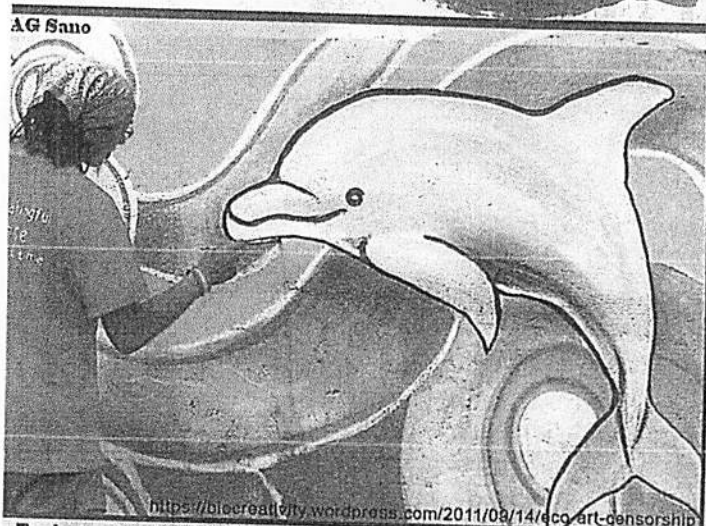
