

DEVELOPMENT OF CONTEXTUALIZED AND INTERACTIVE TEACHING READING TOOLS AND LEARNING MATERIALS

1. In partnership with Educo Philippines' Project LEARN (Learner's Easy Access to Reading and Numeracy) which aims to improve the reading competency of Grade 4 to 6 pupils, the Schools Division Office of Sorsogon through the Office of the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent and the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) identified teacher- writers, illustrators and validators who will be involved in the Writeshops for the Development of Contextualized and Interactive Reading Tools and Learning Materials. The 1st phase of the writeshop was held on July 15-16, 2019 at Casa Lorenzo, Tagas, Daraga, Albay, and the 2nd phase will be conducted on August 1-3, 2019 at Ninong's Hotel, Legazpi City. In order to provide technical support and guidance, these writers and validators will be joined by identified Public Schools District Supervisors, Education Program Supervisors and Project Development Officer (PDO II) from the Curriculum Implementation Division, and District Reading Coordinators of Pilar II & III Districts, as well as the School Reading Coordinators of Naspi ES, Poptol ES, Danlog ES, Mercedes ES & Esperanza ES in Pilar II & III districts.
3. The List of writers, illustrators, validators, technical advisers and reading coordinators are found in the Enclosures of this memorandum.
4. Educo will shoulder the meals and accommodation of the teacher- writers, validators, technical advisers and reading coordinators while travelling expenses shall be charged against Division/ School MOOE.
5. The teachers and personnel involved in these activity could avail of Vacation Service Credits (VSCs)/ Compensatory Overtime Credits (COCs) for their attendance on Saturdays and Sundays.
