

A 10-minute paper evaluation will follow. Dates of regional validation and evaluation will be announced soon through a division advisory.

Schools Heads and School Brigada Eskwela Coordinators of all first placer schools are invited for a meeting-orientation on August 3, 2019, Saturday at 8 o'clock in the morning at DepEd-Sorsogon SGOD office. A one (1) day service credit for teachers and one (1) day compensatory time off (CTO) for non-teaching personnel will be granted.
