**DIVISION ACTION RESEARCH COACHING, MONITORING, ASSESSMENT
AND VALIDATION (DARCMV) ON STRENGTHENING SCIENCE TEACHERS'
RESEARCH CAPABILITIES RE: SDO-SORSOGON PROJECT RISE
(RESEARCH AND INNOVATION FOR SCIENCE ENHANCEMENT)
IN THE SECONDARY LEVEL**

Concerned School Heads
Concerned Science Head Teachers/ Coordinators and Master Teachers

1. As an offshoot of the recently concluded Division Training on Action Research Writing for Science Master Teachers and Head Teachers in the Secondary level, a follow-up support/technical assistance to this group of researchers along the development and implementation of action researches in their respective schools shall be provided through the conduct of the **Division Action Research Coaching, Monitoring, Assessment and Validation (DARCMV)** on Strengthening Science Teachers' Research Capabilities Re: SDO-Sorsogon Project RISE (Research and Innovations for Science Enhancement) in the Secondary Level from September to December, 2019 at Ann's Garden, Juban, Sorsogon.
2. As one of the Project components, this Coaching mechanism shall be provided to:
 - a. scaffold/support the needs of the researchers along the different processes of action research, particularly on their expressed need for technical inputs on data gathering and data analysis, for them to be able to complete and produce quality research projects;
 - b. enhance KSAs of Science Head Teachers and Master Teachers as Coaches and Mentors to co-Science teachers in developing/conducting action researches; and
 - c. strengthen leadership skills of Science HTs and MTs to continually develop among their colleagues the culture of research in the schools as they address issues/challenges along implementation of K to 12 Science curriculum and instruction and ensure improvements in processes, practices and performance; and
 - d. prepare the Science researchers for the conduct of research conferences/ fora.

3. The expected participants in this activity are the Science Master Teachers and Head Teachers/ Coordinators who attended the 5-Day Division Live-In Training on Project RISE conducted last August 2019 at Nature Spring Resort, Monbon, Irosin, Sorsogon. The list of participants is attached. These participants have submitted their action research proposals to this Office and were already approved by the Superintendent.

4. Participants are expected to attend the **Division Action Research Coaching Sessions (DARCS)** on the following schedules:

5. A **School Action Research Monitoring, Assessment and Validation (SARMAV)** shall also be conducted to monitor and track progress of the implementation of the approved action researches, and continuously provide the technical assistance needed by the researcher. As part of the monitoring and validation, classroom observation shall also be conducted.

6. **School Heads are enjoined to extend their technical assistance and full support to their teacher-researchers as they conduct/ implement their actions researches to improve practices and performance of both the teachers and students in their respective schools.**

7. There shall be no Registration fee. Expenses relative to the conduct of this Coaching sessions shall be charged against Division INSET Funds, while travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds/ MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
