Provision of Immune System Protection for the Vulnerable Age Group in the Schools and SDO Employees of DepEd Sorsogon Province Division, A Measure to Prevent Spread of COVID -19

1. One of the gender issues articulated in this year's GAD PLAN for DepEd Sorsogon was the lack of gender health measures that will prevent the spread of the Covid-19, specifically among the vulnerable age group (51-64 years old) teaching and non-teaching personnel who are always in close contacts with the communities and the clients, thus the higher risk of the infection.
2. To close the gaps, the SDO through the Gender and Development initiatives will provide anti-flu vaccine to boost the immune system of the vulnerable age group in the schools and SDO employees as a measure to strengthen them and to prevent further complication brought by the Covid-19.
3. Alongside the immunization activities, the Health Section personnel will provide awareness campaign and education on the proper ways of protecting one's health during the pandemic among employees.
4. The activity will be on November 19-20, 2020 for SDO-based employees and on November 23-26, 2020 for the clusters. Host schools shall arrange for the venue of the activity.
5. The submitted reports on Sex Disaggregated and Other Relevant Data for Gender Analysis by virtue of Division Memorandum No. 149, s, 2020 will be the basis of the equitable distribution of slots for the vaccine. Priority will be given to elementary schools and non-implementing units in the secondary. PSDSs, OIC-PSDSs and Cluster Heads for the secondary schools shall inform the identified priority recipients to report to the indicated venue and schedule stated in Enclosure No.1.
6. Everyone involved in the activity is likewise reminded to strictly observe the required health protocols such as wearing of facemasks and face shields, social distancing, hand sanitation and other precautionary measures.
7. Travel expenses of the recipient employees/ teachers shall be charged against MOOE/local funds while the travel, meals and incidental expenses of the Health Personnel who will facilitate the activity shall be charged against Division GAD Fund/ this Project's Contingency Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
