**2020 REGIONAL BRIGADA ESKWELA AWARDS AND  
STAKEHOLDERS APPRECIATION**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2020 and in consideration of the relevant regulations for the management of COVID-19, DepEd Region V shall hold the annual Regional Brigada Eskwela Awards and Stakeholders' Appreciation this April 2021 to recognize the strong partnership of schools and the education partners.
2. This year's Brigada Eskwela was reconfigured to promote sustainable and safe living and highlighted the convergence efforts to address the required health standards and social issues at home, in the school and in the community, in the context of COVID-19. This was implemented from June 1, 2020 and was extended before the start of the school year on October 5, 2020.
3. The Regional Brigada Eskwela Awards and Stakeholders' Appreciation shall be held following the health protocols and guidelines set forth by the local IATF.
4. For Stakeholders' Appreciation, all Local Government Units (LGUs) with enacted ordinances and resolutions in support to Brigada Eskwela 2020 and Learning Continuity Plan (LCP) will be awarded the **Gawad Brigada**. In view of this, PSDS/ OIC-PSDSs shall secure from the Municipal Office a copy of the ordinance/ resolutions to be submitted at the Regional Office through the endorsement of the Schools Division Superintendent. The deadline of the submission is on February 1, 2021.
5. Included to be given awards are the following:
  - a) Top 2 Local NGAs supportive to DepEd through issuance of memoranda and donations to schools;
  - b) Top 2 major donors from the private sectors;
  - c) Radio Stations with MOU/ MOA for the implementation of the learning continuity;

- d) Top 2 GPTA/ PTA Officials with strong support to DepEd based on their significant contributions and active participation (sufficient MOVs must be submitted by the School Heads to the SDO SGOD SocMobNet for evaluation)

The deadline for submission of supporting documents for items a-d is on February 4, 2021. Late submission will not be honored.



6. For the Regional Brigada Eskwela 2020 Awards, the following will be awarded:
- a) **Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools** (2 schools, one for elementary and one for secondary)
  - b) **Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School Heads** (2 schools, one for elementary and one for secondary; from the schools with the Best Implementing Schools for Brigada Eskwela in the New Normal)
  - c) **Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing School Coordinators** (2 schools, one for elementary and one for secondary; from the schools with the Best Implementing Schools for Brigada Eskwela in the New Normal)

Requirements to be submitted on or before **February 5, 2021** at the SDO SGOD-SMN:

One-page significant accomplishments of the schools along the criteria in narrative form with 2-3 clear photos. The accomplishments shall be prepared in a powerpoint, with 3-4 slides to be saved in a USB.

Personal essay both of the school heads and coordinators in times of pandemic and calamities with at least 100 words written in A4 size bond paper, double spaced in Filipino or English. Clear photos of them should be saved in a USB.

7. Considering the extent of Brigada Eskwela Implementation and the outstanding performance of the awardees, as a form of additional incentive, the SDO shall provide additional points to them when they apply for promotion.
