1. In accordance with the purpose of the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) to contribute in the improvement of performance specifically on learning outcomes and to ensure full implementation of the articulated basic education curriculum, through: **localizing and indigenizing curriculum; enforcing standards; and providing access to quality and varied learning resources**, the Curriculum Implementation Division - Learning Resource Management and Development System (CID-LRMDS) will conduct a One Day Orientation of the Quality Assurance and Validation Team for Grade 3 Araling Panlipunan Localized Learning Material on February 8, 2020 at SDO Library Hub, Sorsogon City.

2. The activity aims to:

- Capacitate identified teachers along the standards on quality assurance and validation of localized learning resources
- Present the timeline on the pilot testing and other activities relevant to the development of the Araling Panlipunan modules.

3. In line with this, the Education Program Supervisor for Araling Panlipunan is requested to fast track the submission to the LRMDS Unit of the remaining modules of Barcelona and Donsol to facilitate the **complete validation** of all **14 Orgulyo** modules. Likewise, softcopies of the 14 modules will be needed by validation and QA team since there was only 1 hard copy per municipality submitted to the LRMDS Unit.
