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

### Explanatory Notes

Fellow RDs!

This document provides the basis of the allocation for the upcoming 2023 NQESH slots slated May 2024. It may be recalled that the HROD requested for RDs request for comparative analysis and possible distribution of additional slots in case of variance. The HROD provided the basic known information to the region as basis for their requests. It is noted that only a few closely approximate the equitable distribution of NQESH allocation. Submitted requests range from 8 to 187 times higher than the current vacancies to be filled up. The HROD fully understands the underlying factor – to create a pool of qualified SHs for possible placement in case of future vacancies. However, given the limited slots of 22,000 for 2023, the HROD is constrained to distribute accordingly based on seemingly sound parameters.

Available data include, number of existing vacancies, number of schools, number of priority items as a universe of test takers, the passing rate by region over the NQESH journey and the submitted requests.

Given budget constraints, we cannot test all priority takers. Hence, slots should be allocated equitably. The immediate resolve is to fill up vacancies and relatedly the number of expectant passers for CAT A be able to register higher average passing rate than 0.080 percent nationwide. In similar vein, it is assumed that the 1,933 vacancies can be filled up if the passing rate is improved.

The total vacancy to date is .02% of the total number of schools and 0.04% when compared to the number of schools. Hence, the HROD action revolves around the basic question hereunder posted:

*Given the NQESH average passing rate over the years, how many slots can be allocated per region based on 91,429 priority takers out of the 22,000 available for the year such that the region should have a pool at most 6 times number of passers to fill up 1,933 current vacancies or immediate future?*

The allocation herein provided (see attached) factored in all variables mentioned above. The HROD requests for understanding from the RDs as this is the most appropriate approach to equitably distribute the slots across region. It is with high hopes that the test takers fully prepare for the examination and improve the passing rate by at least 20% to fully fill up existing vacancy and a pool for promotion either by natural vacancy or reclassification in the immediate future.
