BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TRAINING OF TRAINERS FOR SCHOOL HEALTH AND NUTRITION SECTION AND SELECTED PERSONNEL

1. The Republic Act No. 10871 otherwise known as the Basic Life Support (BLS) Training in Schools Act mandates age-appropriate BLS training for basic education learners. The Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR) particularly Rule II Section 5.2, emphasizes the Department of Education's (DepEd) responsibility to integrate BLS training into the comprehensive school curriculum. Further, Rule IV, Section 10 states that BLS training is mandatory for all DepEd personnel, particularly those who may serve as resource persons or trainers, ensuring efficient and effective BLS for basic education students.
2. In view of the foregoing, the Department of Education (DepEd) Schools Division Office (SDO) of the Province of Sorsogon in partnership with the Sorsogon Provincial Health Office – Health Emergency Management Staff (PHO – HEMS) will conduct the Basic Life Support – Training of Trainers (BLS-TOT) for School Health And Nutrition Section and selected teaching and non-teaching personnel. The letter from Provincial Health Officer II Dr. Renato B. Bolo, addressed to Schools Division Superintendent William E. Gando, CESO VI on February 15, 2024 is attached as reference.
3. The BLS-TOT is in conformity with DepEd Sorsogon Province's Division Change Plan crafted by Schools Division Superintendent **William E. Gando** with the Vision: Total Holistic Education through Vibrant Integrated Linkages with Leaderships, Alliances, Groups and Entities to Individually Nurture Children (**THE VILLAGE INC**) and aligned with the **CPR Ready Sorsogon Program** of the Provincial Government of Sorsogon under the leadership of **Governor Jose Edwin B. Hamor**.
