- 1. In connection with the on-going effort of the Division to provide access to basic education services to all school-aged children in the 14 municipalities of Sorsogon, this Office hereby announces the General Guidelines for the conduct of the Division-Led Child-mapping activity.
- 2. Attached to this memorandum are the guidelines for the activity, including the following annexes:
 - ✓ Annex 1: Modified Child-Mapping Tool
 - ✓ Annex 2: Barangay-School Assignments per District
- 3. The Barangay-School assignments from the remaining school districts not included in Annex 2 will be announced through an addendum, once their respective district offices submit the said document, pursuant to the Division Memorandum No. 20, s. 2025.
- 4. Schools are expected to cascade these guidelines to their chosen personnel who will be involved, through a school-based orientation to be facilitated by the school representatives who attended the division orientation, per Division Memorandum No. 45, s. 2025. The slideshow presentation is now available for download at the link provided during the division orientation.
- 5. Expenses incurred by schools related to the implementation of activities related to this child-mapping, such as, but not limited to the conduct of orientation and travel expenses for data gathering, are chargeable against their respective school MOOE/ Local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules & regulations.
- 6. Immediate & widest dissemination and compliance of this Memorandum are directed.

END OF SY 2024-2025 DIVISION-LED CHILD MAPPING GUIDELINES

I. RATIONALE

The Basic Education Development Plan (BEDP) 2030, issued through DepEd Order No. 24, series 2022, was able to set the strategic direction and priorities of the agency through its results framework, highlighting the different intermediate outcomes and enabling mechanisms to achieve the department's sector outcome and goal. The Intermediate Outcome No. 1: Access aims that "All school-aged children, outof-school youth and adults accessed relevant basic learning opportunities." However, the latest available enrollment rates for the past three school years, from SY 2021-2022, SY 2022-2023, to SY 2023-2024, have shown a consistent decline in the proportion of school-aged children who are enrolled in schools in the Province of Sorsogon. This is supported by the decreasing enrollment data from SY 2021-2022 to SY 2024-2025.

Ensuring that all school-aged children in the communities receive basic education services remains to be a challenge. Effective intervention programs which are within the context of the diverse setting of the Division's 531 public elementary and secondary schools, are crucial in achieving the said intermediate outcome. This can be addressed efficiently with timely and relevant data on the actual status of school-aged children in the province, including reasons for not enrolling, not continuing, and not finishing the K-12 basic education.

This can only be addressed if the Division implements a systematic and regular conduct of child-mapping activities. However, with 531 schools and all the complexities in school choices of families, this endeavor of mapping all school-aged children in the communities in the province needs a well-coordinated effort with all schools in the Division level.

In Annex 1B of the enclosure to DepEd Order No. 44, s. 2015, schools are directed to conduct Child-Mapping activities at least every three years or every time a major event occurs which impacts the population of the communities within the schools. However, if schools are left to decide on their own to conduct the activity, duplication of mapping of households and non-mapping of far-flung communities are likely to happen. A well-planned, systematic approach is incumbent to ensure that the efforts of schools are maximized, and no school-aged children is left unaccounted for.

Hence, the Division-led Child Mapping Activity before the start of the next School Year will be implemented with the enclosed guidelines.

II. SCOPE

These guidelines for the Division-led Child Mapping Activity are limited to the Four (4) – year-old children, official school-aged children in 14 municipalities of Sorsogon aged 5-17 years old, those aged 18 and above but still attending basic education or the Alternative Learning System (ALS). Learners from outside the 14 municipalities but enrolled in schools within the Division of Sorsogon will also be covered by the mapping activity.

III. METHODOLOGY

A. Modified Child-Mapping Tool

The division-led child-mapping activity will utilize a modified child-mapping tool (Please see Annex 1). The modified child mapping tool is adapted from Annex 1B of the enclosure in DepEd Order No. 044, series 2015. The same general data will be gathered by the modified tool and is focused on knowing the following key information about the children in the communities:

- Name
- Demographic Information
- Residence
- Disability
- Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) for 4-year-olds
- Educational Status
- Future Enrollment

B. Actual Data Collection (Child-Mapping)

To ensure efficiency of the division-led child-mapping activity, each school is assigned with a set of communities to be mapped, as guided by Annex 2: Barangay-School Assignments.

For uniformity of the data collected, the reference for time-related and time-dependent data will be the fourth quarter of SY 2024-2025 (Example: for "Grade")

Level" entries, it should be answered with the grade level of the learner for SY 2024-2025 and not the grade level for the next school year.)

Schools must coordinate with community leaders and village officials to ensure the safety of the school personnel who will collect data from the field. Guided by the modified child mapping tool, school personnel must account for each household in the communities who have at least one child with the following age:

- 4 years old as of August 31, 2024
- 5-17 years old regardless of educational status
- 18 years old and above who are still attending K-12 formal basic education

All accomplished modified child-mapping tools shall be signed, compiled, and submitted to their respective district offices, once they are encoded in the online reporting facility.

C. Online Reporting

The data from the modified child mapping tool must be reported through an online facility. This ensures uniformity of data being sent and allows the data managers to clean and process data efficiently, in preparation for the data analysis.

D. Contextualized Implementation of Schools

Schools are given flexibility to implement strategies in carrying out the child-mapping activity, as long as the following conditions are met and ensured:

- Safety of school personnel is guaranteed.
- All school personnel involved are properly informed of their roles and assignments.
- All target households are accounted. If reliable, timely and accurate data
 for the modified child-mapping tool are available in the school or in other
 local offices such as Barangay health centers, Barangay/ Municipal halls,
 etc., schools may dispense house interviews.
- The copies of modified child mapping tool are duly accomplished with accurate data.

- The accomplished copies of modified child mapping tool are signed and compiled.
- All entries in the modified child mapping tool are properly encoded and transmitted online.
- The right to privacy of interviewees is well-respected.
- The timelines set are properly followed.

V. GRANT OF VACATION SERVICE CREDITS AND/ OR LEAVE CREDITS

A. For Teaching Personnel

- 1. No teaching personnel shall conduct mapping activities during his/her official classroom instructional time. Hence, child-mapping-related activities, such as data gathering or online reporting, that may be given to teachers, shall be done beyond the official hours of service.
- 2. Following the guidelines set forth in DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024, teachers conducting child-mapping-related activities are entitled to a maximum of 30 days of vacation service credits (VSC).
- 3. Schools shall exercise prudence and fairness in assigning tasks to ensure that teachers involved are provided with the same maximum number of VSCs and their actual teaching work is not compromised. The following guidelines from section V.A.1 of DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024 shall be followed in computing the VSC of the teachers involved:

- i. For child-mapping-related activities performed beyond regular work hours during school days, one (1) hour of service shall be equal to 1.25 hours of VSC.
- ii. For child-mapping-related activities performed during weekends, summer/ long vacation or holidays, one (1) hour of service shall be equal to 1.50 hours of VSC.
- 4. During school days, no teacher shall exceed more than 2 hours of overtime work for child-mapping-related activities. On the other hand, during weekends/ holidays/ summer vacation, teachers are allowed a maximum of 8 hours per day of overtime work.
- 5. Other provisions in DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024 shall apply for the granting of VSCs. Supplemental issuances may be released to facilitate the processing of special orders.

B. For Non-Teaching/Teaching-related

- 1. Following the CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, non-teaching and teaching-related personnel will also be granted Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) who will be conducting child-mapping-related activities during weekends and/or holidays.
- 2. Per paragraph 5.4.2, for child-mapping-related activities performed weekends or holidays, one (1) hour of service shall be equal to 1.50 hours of COC.
- 3. Per paragraph 5.5.1, each personnel may accrue not more than 40 hours of COCs in a month.
- 4. No personnel shall conduct overtime work for child-mapping-related activities during regular workdays or Sundays. Overtime work for the same purpose is only allowed during Saturdays or holidays.
- 5. Other provisions in the CSC-DBM joint circular no. 2, s. 2004 shall apply for the granting of COCs. Supplemental issuances may be released to facilitate the processing of special orders.




