## REGIONAL LIVE-OUT ACCREDITATION TRAINING FOR COACHES IN VARIOUS SPORTS DISCIPLINES

- 1. This is to inform the field of the conduct of the Regional Live-Out Accreditation Training for Coaches in Various Sports Disciplines at the designated training venues and dates.
- 2. The objectives of this accreditation training are the following:
  - a. Standardize coaching qualifications and competencies across all sports events by establishing a unified accreditation process aligned with national standards.
  - b. Update coaches on the latest rules, guidelines, and sport-specific protocols, including developments in sports science, injury prevention, training methodologies, and athlete welfare.
  - c. Assess and accredit qualified coaches for their respective sports disciplines, ensuring that only trained and certified personnel of DepEd Region V are authorized to handle official school sports teams.
