DIVISION SIYENSPARK PROGRAM IN SCIENCE ELEMENTARY

1. As part of the **2025 Science Month Celebration** pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 264, s. 2022, declaring every year of the month of September as **National Science Club Month**, the SDO Sorsogon Province joins in the celebration with a month-long activity from **September 1-30, 2025**, with the theme, "*Spatialyze: Surveying Societies, Sensing Solutions.*"
2. This Office launches the **SiyenSpark** program for elementary Science – a fusion of *Siyensya* and *Spark*, a dynamic platform for experiential learning through academic competitions, beyond the classroom. This activity aims to ignite academic excellence, strengthen scientific literacy and cultivate a lasting appreciation for science among elementary learners.
3. Below are the SiyenSpark activities to be conducted in all public elementary schools in the division. Private schools, in coordination with the district offices, are also welcome to join the activities.
 - a. *SiyenSpark Quiz*. A fast-paced, knowledge-driven competition that tests Key Stage 2 learners' mastery of core science concepts, promoting comprehension, and critical thinking.
 - b. *SiyenSpark Spelling*. A specialized spelling bee focused on scientific terms and concepts from the Key Stage 1 Science curriculum, enhancing vocabulary, accuracy, and confidence in science communication.
 - c. *SiyenSpark Poster*. An on-the-spot sci-art challenge that sparks creativity by translating scientific ideas into visually compelling and conceptually accurate illustrations.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF SIYENSPARK COMPETITION

1. Each school and district shall conduct its own competition to select the best contestants in each event to represent in the Division SiyenSpark.
2. Participants in the competition are currently enrolled pupils from both public and private elementary schools in the SDO Sorsogon Province.
3. The Division SiyenSpark contest categories are as follows:

Event & Category	Number of Participants	Number of Coaches
1. SiyenSpark Quiz		
Individual	1 from Key stage 2	1
Team	1 Group with 3 members (1 contestant in each Grade level from Key stage 2)	At least 1 but not more than 3
2. SiyenSpark Spelling		
Individual	1 from Key stage 1 (Grade 3 Only)	1
3. SiyenSpark Poster		
Individual	1 from Key stage 2	1
Expected Total No. of Contestants & Coaches Per District	6	6

4. Only the FIRST PLACER in each event shall represent the District in the Division level competition.
5. **A contestant is allowed to participate in one category only.**
6. There will be a common place for all contest categories.
7. Coaches are not allowed to stay beside their contestants. Strictly no coaching shall be allowed while the contest is going on. This shall be a ground for disqualification of the contestants.
8. The mechanics and criteria of the contest per category shall be strictly followed.
9. In each category, five (5) winners shall be declared through ranking system:
 - Champion
 - First Runner-up
 - Second Runner-up
 - Third Runner-up
 - Fourth Runner-up
10. The decision of the board of Judges shall be final and irrevocable.
11. Violation of the guidelines can be a ground for disqualification of the contestants.

SIYENSPARK QUIZ MECHANICS
(School level)

1. This competition is open to all bona fide intermediate (Grade 4-6) pupils from the school.
2. An elimination round for each grade level shall be conducted using a 30-item, pen-and-paper test which will be administered during their science classes.
3. The top 5 scorers for each grade level shall compete in the school-level SiyenSpark Quiz, for a total of 15 individual quizzers.
4. For the competition proper, each contestant shall be provided with a marker and a writing board.
5. There shall be three (3) rounds for the quiz: Easy, Average, and Difficult. A Clincher round will be added if needed. There shall be ten (10) easy questions, five (5) average, and five (5) difficult questions. All contestants shall answer all questions in the three rounds. Each correct answer in every round will be given corresponding points, to wit:

Easy - 1 point; Average - 2 points; and Difficult - 3 points

6. Each question must be answered within the allocated time for it. Ten (10) seconds for non-computational and thirty (30) seconds for computational.
7. The quizmaster shall read each question twice and the time shall start only after the quizmaster says "GO".
8. The contestant may begin to answer only after the quizmaster says "GO".
9. The contestant must write his/her final answer on the answer sheet. If the contestant wishes to change his/her answer, the former answer should be crossed out and the final answer encircled.
10. All answers must be spelled correctly to be considered correct. This shall be a basis in declaring of the correct answer. **Use of calculators shall not be allowed.**
11. After the time limit has expired, each contestant must show his/her answer to the audience before the quizmaster reads the correct answer. Solutions may be checked by the board of judges if needed.
12. The total score of the contestant after the three rounds shall be his/her score.
13. The contestant with the highest final score shall be declared as champion, the second highest as first runner-up, the third highest as second runner-up, the fourth highest score as third runner-up, and the fifth highest score as fourth runner-up.
14. In case of a tie, a clincher round shall be played. It shall be a knockout system between or among the contestants with equal scores until a winner emerges. The first one who can answer correctly will be the winner.
15. The duly registered coach of the contestant is the only person authorized to file a protest. All protest should be referred to the board of judges before the quizmaster reads the next question. No protest shall be entertained by the board of judges once the quiz master started reading the question.
16. Any violation of the aforementioned rule/s shall cause the disqualification of the contestants concerned.



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17. The champion will represent the school in the district-level SiyenSpark Quiz for Individual category.
18. Excluding the champion, the top scorer for each grade level will form the 3-member team of the school who will join the district-level SiyenSpark Quiz for the Team Category.

SIYENSPARK QUIZ MECHANICS
(District level - Individual Category)

1. School-level SiyenSpark champions from within the district shall compete with each other. In the event that the school champion is unavailable due to valid reasons, the school may opt to send a substitute among the top scorers during their school-level SiyenSpark Quiz. The determination of the validity of the reason of unavailability shall be objectively decided by the District Science Coordinator for elementary.
2. For the competition proper, each contestant shall be provided with a marker and a writing board.
3. There shall be three (3) rounds for the quiz: Easy, Average, Difficult. A Clincher round will be added if needed. There shall be ten (10) easy questions, five (5) average, and five (5) difficult questions. All contestants shall answer all questions in the three rounds. Each correct answer in every round will be given corresponding points, to wit:

Easy - 1 point; Average - 2 points; and Difficult - 3 points

4. Each question must be answered within the allocated time for it. Ten (10) seconds for non-computational and thirty (30) seconds for computational.
5. The quizmaster shall read each question twice and the time shall start only after the quizmaster says "GO".
6. The contestant may begin to answer only after the quizmaster says "GO".

2. In the event that (a) member(s) is/are unavailable due to valid reasons, the school may opt to send (a) substitute(s) among the top scorers during their school-level SiyenSpark Quiz, provided that the team structure by grade level is still observed. The determination of the validity of the reason of unavailability shall be objectively decided by the District Science Coordinator for elementary.
3. For the competition proper, each team shall be provided with a marker and a writing board.
4. There shall be three (3) rounds for the quiz: Easy, Average, Difficult. A Clincher round will be added if needed. There shall be ten (10) easy questions, five (5) average, and five (5) difficult questions. All contestants shall answer all questions in the three rounds. 4. For the competition proper, each contestant shall be provided with a marker and a writing board.
5. There shall be three (3) rounds for the quiz: Easy, Average, and Difficult. A Clincher round will be added if needed. There shall be ten (10) basic vocabulary words for easy round, five (5) challenging words for average round, and five (5) Advanced vocabulary words for difficult round. All contestants shall spell the words in the three rounds. Each correct answer in every round will be given corresponding points, to wit:

Easy - 1 point; Average - 2 points; and Difficult - 3 points

6. Each scientific term or science word must be spelled within the allocated time for it. Ten (10) seconds for easy round, twenty (20) seconds for average round, and thirty (30) seconds for difficult round.
7. The spelling master shall pronounce each word twice and the time shall start only after the spelling master says "GO".

SIYENSPARK POSTER MECHANICS & CRITERIA
(School level - Individual Category)

1. This competition is open to all bona fide intermediate (Grade 4-6) pupils from the school.
2. The poster-making is an on-the-spot event.
3. The contestants must illustrate, interpret, emphasize, and expound on the 2025 NSCM theme in a 1/4 illustration board with portrait layout and no margin using oil pastel only.
4. The contestants shall bring his/her own poster materials such as 1/4 illustration board and oil pastel.
5. The contestants are given a maximum of three (3) hours and thirty (30) minutes to finish the poster.
6. The contestants are not allowed to bring pictures or images as references to their entries.
7. The poster must be an original design. The contestants will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regard to the originality and authenticity of the design.
8. The contestants must come on time. However, late participants shall still be accommodated but the time shall not be extended.
9. Below are the contest criteria:

10. The champion will represent the school in the district-level SiyenSpark Poster.

(District level - Individual Category)

1. School-level SiyenSpark poster champions from within the district shall compete with each other.
