1. Attached is **Regional Memorandum No. 1437** titled "Observance of Filipino Values Month (FVM)" issued in line with the **Moral Recovery Program (MRP)** and pursuant to **Presidential Proclamation No. 62** dated September 30, 1992, and **Proclamation No. 479** signed on October 25, 1994 declaring the month of **November** of every year as **Filipino Values Month**.
2. This observance aims to:
  - a. Strengthen the Filipino culture, values, and ideals that are pro-God, pro-People, pro-Country, and pro-Nature;
  - b. Mobilize all Filipinos for nation-building through the practical exercise of human values in their daily lives as citizens; and
  - c. Awaken all Filipinos to the power of these values in achieving both individual and national goals.
3. The theme for this year's celebration of the **Filipino Values Month (November 1–30, 2025)** is: **"Bagong Pilipinas, Bagong Pag-asa: Pagkakaisa at Pananagutan Para sa Makabuluhang Pagbabago."** This theme underscores the collective hope of every Filipino in realizing the vision of Bagong Pilipinas. It emphasizes the importance of unity (pagkakaisa) and accountability



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(pananagutan) as key elements toward meaningful transformation and progress.

4. All schools are encouraged to conduct school and community-based programs, projects, and activities that promote cooperation, responsibility, and shared commitment to sustainable and inclusive development.
5. The practice of Filipino values should not be confined to the month of November but must be lived and demonstrated in everyday life.
