CRITERIA FOR THE 2022 BRIGADA ESKWELA BEST IMPLEMENTING SCHOOLS AND SPECIAL AWARDS

- 1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 062, s. 2022 entitled 2022 Brigada Eskwela Implementing Guidelines, this Office through the Schools Governance Division shall recognize the 2022 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools and special awardees.
- 2. The search for the 2022 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools shall be based on the framework relative to the new normal endemic phase situation. This includes the engagement of stakeholders and addressing problems, queries and other concerns in preparation for the start of classes in the prescribed mode of learning delivery. In relation to this, all BE activities should highlight partnership initiatives that complement with DepEd's initiatives in preparing schools for the opening of classes.
- 3. To give due recognition to schools whose efforts in the implementation of the Brigada Eskwela program are exemplary, the SDO shall be awarding the Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools Award based on the following criteria:

Medium School	16 – 30
Large School	31 - 50
Mega School	51 and above

<u>Note:</u> **INTEGRATED SCHOOL** (Kindergarten to Grade 12) may choose which level they intend to participate in the selection.

- 6. The Schools Division Superintendent with the assistance of the SGOD shall be allowed to exercise their sound discretion as to how to allocate the scores to be received by the Brigada Eskwela implementing schools based on the aforementioned general criteria. District Offices may opt to conduct a local search or nominate entries for the Division Search.
- 7. The time frame for the submission of letter of intent and supporting documents for the 2022 Best Implementing Schools and Brigada Eskwela Special Awards will be from September 27-30, 2022. All MOV per criterion must be properly organized in one (1) hard bound folder each. Late submission of documents and addons will no longer be accepted. The conduct of the oral presentation, paper screening and panel interview will be announced in a separate memorandum. The oral presentation shall be done within 10 minutes for every school.
