

OVERVIEW

Good Neighbors International Philippines (GNIP) continues its goal to "Improve the well-being of Filipinos through building a sustainable partnership to empower children, youth, and communities" focusing on Economic Development, Social Development, Sponsorship Services, and other Community Support Programs, Projects, and Advocacies.

As we look forward to the post-COVID-19 pandemic future, GNP organized a WAVE Talk event, WAVE stands for Words Amplifying Virtue of Empowerment with the theme, "Empower Through Social Responsibility", last October 29, 2022, at Seda Vertis North Hotel, Quezon City.

The onsite event was successfully attended by different representative stakeholders from the national government, non-government organizations, youth-led organizations, private sectors, and students from GNP community development project areas.

Its goal is to spark conversation, wave connections, and empower the youth wherein all participants had the opportunity to be engaged on the most pressing issues facing their generation today and empowered them to create a wave-like action through social responsibility that will ripple a positive effect of change in the community, economy, and environment.

What is GNIP?

Good Neighbors International Philippines (GNIP) is an international, non-profit humanitarian and development organization centered on the well-being of marginalized Filipino children through child sponsorship and integrated community development programs. At present, it is operating in 11 vulnerable communities scattered in various parts of the country.

Its community development programs are geared towards the sustainable development of vulnerable communities. These programs cover various sectors that affect the well-being of children. These include Child Sponsorship, Education, Child Protection and Advocacy, Health, Water, Sanitation, Hygiene or WASH, Income Generation, Energy and Environment, Disaster Risk Reduction, and Partnership and Network Building.

Good Neighbors International is able to implement its developmental and humanitarian interventions to children and their families in the communities where it operates through partnering with various companies, organizations, and individuals who share in its vision and mission for the marginalized sector. They engage them to become donors and sponsors through local child sponsorship and fundraising campaigns. GNIP also partners with companies to carry out the latter's corporate social responsibility programs to benefit their community development areas. To help ensure the sustainability of its community development programs in the areas, GNIP also partners with the local government units and other local agencies that operate in the communities through its advocacy initiatives. Partnership with them also includes capacity building and resource mobilization.

3. Driving Action on Climate Change

Climate change is one of the most significant challenges facing global society and driving action on climate change will provide young people with the latest information regarding greenhouse emissions. Thus far, how can young people today help in mitigating climate change and find ways to limit global warming, and take care of our planet?
