	The school shall be responsible for the establishment and maintenance of school gardens, as well as the production of seeds for the next cropping and partnership with stakeholders and the community.			
e.	School gardens shall be continuously maintained and sustained thru establishment of nurseries, seed production in partnership with stakeholders.			
	School gardens shall be secured to protect the crops from stray animals.			
	Organic fertilizer and inputs will be used to enhance soil fertility and improve production yield.			
	Each school shall include/involve PTA stakeholders to conduct and maintain the school garden every summer as a measure to sustain the garden, and to prepare for the opening of the school year.
