In support to Deped Order 36, s. 2016 which aims to give all learners equal opportunity to excel in relation to the standard set by the curriculum and focus on their performance rather than to compete with one another and the desire to develop the unique talents, skills and self-confidence of our learners in the SDO Sorsogon Province, this office is encouraging teachers and learners to create an Innovative Audio-Visual Learning Materials dubbed as *LETSTOK*, thus a one day Division Training Workshop intended for 35 District Reading Coordinators in Elementary and Secondary School Reading Coordinators is being scheduled on November 17, 2023 at Deped SDO Bulwagan ng Karunungan.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. develop and achieve the mastery level of the learners in all learning areas.
 - b. create an innovative audio - visual materials focusing on the different subject areas both in Elementary and Secondary Levels.
