### PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES OF PROJECT KAAKBAY OF THE UNILAB FOUNDATION IN THE PROVINCE OF SORSOGON

To: School Principals/Heads and Concerned Teachers of the following schools:

- Donsol National Comprehensive High School (1st District)
- Pilar National Comprehensive High School (1st District)
- Gubat National High School (2<sup>nd</sup> District)
- Gallanosa National High School (2<sup>nd</sup> District)
- Bulan National High School (2nd District)

This is in reference to the partnership between the Schools Division Office of Sorsogon and the Unilab Foundation, Inc. to implement Project Kaakbay in the five (5) identified Junior and Senior High Schools in the Province of Sorsogon. It aims to equip 200 students with knowledge and skills to be effective and reliable health allies and first-aid community health responders in their respective school communities.

In line with this, the Project Kaakbay will conduct their first activity on December 09 to 11, 2023 at Gallanosa National High School, Irosin, Sorsogon, in which an Enabling Skills and Basic Life Support Training will be given to the 200 selected students from the 5 identified schools.

In this regard, the Unilab Foundation-Kaakbay team is requesting from the identified schools their cooperation and immediate actions on the following:

- 1. Each school must endorse 40 students to participate in the activity on December 09 to 11, 2023. The 40 students will be the official participants of each school for the upcoming activities of the Project Kaakbay until August 2024. In selecting students, here are the qualifications:
  - a. Ages 15 to 30 Years Old;
  - b. Composed of 20 Grade 9 STE and 20 Grade 11 STEM students;

- For Grade 9 students, at least there is a leadership potential based on the assessment of school (teacher, principal and other school personnel involved);
- d. For Grade 11 Students, preferably from the STEM strand under academic track;
- e. Selected participants must be advocates of health or willing to be health allies in their communities.
- 2. The selected student-participants from each school must be accompanied by two Science Teachers (from JHS and SHS). The list of participants should be submitted to the Division Office, c/o Ms. Michelle H. Guadamor on or before December 6, 2023.
- 3. The participants should register on or before December 06, 2023 through this link: <a href="https://bit.ly/PK-Sorsogon">https://bit.ly/PK-Sorsogon</a> for monitoring and database purposes.
- 4. Each school shall assign a personnel who will serve as coordinator of Project Kaakbay in all of their activities. The assigned coordinator will also help in monitoring the students in their schools.
- 5. The Enabling Skills and Basic Life Support Training on December 09 to 11, 2023 will be held at Gallanosa National High School, Irosin, Sorsogon. The participants will be staying at the venue 3 days and 2 nights. With this, the following details are provided:
  - a. The transportation arrangement (back and forth) will be arranged by the Schools Division Office. The schools will receive an update on or before December 07, 2023 regarding their transportation service;
  - b. The participants shall prepare their clothes, towels and toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.) that are good for 3 days and 2 nights stay at the venue;
  - c. They shall bring their own sleeping mats/pads, blankets and pillows;
  - d. Their meals and snacks (breakfast, AM snack, lunch, PM snack and dinner) will be fully covered by the Unilab-Kaakbay.
- 6. The Enabling Skills Training, which will be mainly facilitated by the Project Kaakbay Team aims to strengthen the following areas of competencies listed below:
  - a. Leadership and Values Formation
  - b. Fundamentals of Project Management
  - c. Community Building
- 7. The Basic Life Support Training which will be facilitated by (DRRMO or Red Cross Sorsogon Chapter) aims to equip them with knowledge and skills to be certified first-aiders and community health responders. The cost of this training will be taken care of Project Kaakbay of the Unilab Foundation.


Projejct Kaakbay aims to equip the youth with knowledge and skills to be a reliable health allies and firstaid primary health care responders in their communities.

communities.


# Why in Sorsogon?




