REASSIGNMENT OF FIELD OFFICIALS


To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

This is to disseminate to the field and inform the concerned officials of their new assignments as detailed below. They may get their advice from the Human Resource and Management Office c/o Mr. Karl Gideon Grefalda.

District Supervisors of affected districts of the reassignments of certain officials will recommend to this office through the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, Bernie Despabiladero, plotting of school heads ASAP, abiding by existing policies on personnel movements such as D.O. No. 7 s. 1999. It is also recommended that feedback about the school heads be solicited from teachers, to be treated with utmost confidentiality, but must be considered heavily in the proposed deployments.

All previously designated Division Coordinators are hereby terminated and they, including displaced officials affected by these reassignments will be temporarily detailed at the District Office to assist in the functions of the PSDS while waiting for further advice.



REDISTRICTING OF SCHOOLS IN SDO SORSOGON

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief, CID and SGOD Education Program Supervisors Public Schools District Supervisors Section/Unit Heads All Concerned

- 1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum dated December 6, 2018 Re: Approval of the Feasibility Study on the Redistricting of public elementary and secondary schools in SDO Sorsogon and favorably recommending its rightsizing into a large category and corollary to the provisions of RA 9155 in applying the principles of decentralization and shared governance, this Office announces the redistricting of schools in the two legislative districts of the Province of Sorsogon.

- 3. It is emphasized that the proposed central schools of the new districts may change subject for conformance with standards/parameters like enrolment, teachers, school sites, academic performance, among others. Moreover, the designation of PSDSs, Officers-In-Charge, school heads and teachers is not permanent and they may be deployed where their services are most needed or in the exigency of service.
- 4. It is expected that all education stakeholders will be informed of this redistricting to ensure their usual cooperation, collaboration and meaningful engagement towards the realization of DepEd's vision, mission, goals and objectives.
- 5. Expenses related to the implementation of this redistricting will be charged against local funds/MOOE/SEF/PTA and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
