**CORREGENDUM and ADDENDUM TO DOPED MEMORANDUM NO. 121, S. 2002,  
 Re- Guidelines for Rating Athletes / Participants in all DepED Paloro /  
 Cultural / Academic Contests**

To: **All Schools Division Superintendents**

In view of the Regional Memorandum No. 121, S. 2002, re- Guidelines for Rating athletes / participants in all DepED Paloro / Cultural / Academic Contests, the following corrigendum / Addendum are hereby issued for the guidance and compliance of all concerned:

- A.) The grade/rating of athletes/ participants during the time that they are included in the designation list as representative of the school/district/division/region to the school/district/provincial/regional/national level sports/cultural/academic activities such as NAMCOA, Dance Drama, Literary/Musical Contest, Science, English, Filipino, Math Contests, Fresh Conference, Pop Quiz, etc. shall be increased but never decreased in the academic and vocational subjects and shall earn more points in Physical Education subjects for athletes.
- B.) All concerned athletes/ participants should be encouraged by school heads/administrators to attend make-up classes, submit special projects and comply with other subject requirements in order to avail of the aforementioned increase in their grade/ratings. Failure to do so, the rating of said athletes/ participants shall be retained but they shall not be given failing grades in any of their subjects.
- C.) Table below shows the corresponding points which will be given to athletes/ participants who complied with the requirements and participated/ received awards in DepED Paloro/Cultural/Academic Contests.

Awards	School/District/Division	Regional/National Level
Gold	Maximum of 4 pts.	Maximum of 8 pts.
Silver	Maximum of 3 pts.	Maximum of 7 pts.
Bronze	Maximum of 2 pts.	Maximum of 6 pts.
Participant	1 pt.	Maximum of 3 pts.

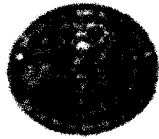

**ADDENDUM TO DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 21, S. 2010**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

In view of Regional Memorandum No. 121, s. 2002 re' **Guidelines for Rating athletes/campus journalists and other participants in all DepED Palaro, Cultural, Academic Conferences and Contests**, the following addendum are hereby issued for guidance and compliance of all concerned:

- A. The grading/rating of athletes/campus journalists/participants in other academic & cultural endeavors during the time that they are in the delegation list as representatives of the school/district/regional/national level in sports, cultural and academic activities such as PALARO, Read-a-Thon, Science/Maths Quizzes, Press Conference, and other quizzes, shall be increased but NEVER decreased in the academic and vocational subjects and shall gain more points in the event/s participated in.
- B. All concerned (athletes/participants) should be encouraged by the school heads to attend make-up classes, submit special projects and comply with other appropriate requirements in order to avail of the aforementioned increase in their grades/rating. Failure to do so, the rating of said athletes / participants shall be retained but in no case be given failing grades in any of their subjects.
- C. Table below shows the corresponding points (as revised) which shall be given to the pupils/students concerned after complying with the necessary requirements commensurate to the awards received, to wit:

Awards	District	Division	Regional	National
Gold	Maximum of 2 points	Maximum of 4 points	Maximum of 6 points	Maximum of 8 points
Silver	Maximum of 2 points	Maximum of 3 points	Maximum of 5 points	Maximum of 6 points
Bronze	Maximum of 1 point	Maximum of 2 points	Maximum of 4 points	Maximum of 5 points
Participant/Delegate	Maximum of 1.5 points	Maximum of 1 point	Maximum of 3 points	Maximum of 4 points
